

Born at Kodungallur (Kerala) in 1935, he graduated from Madras University and did his Post graduation in Zoology from Bihar University. He was a rank holder. He joined Netarhat Vidyalaya as a teacher in 1960 and retired as Principal in 1995. As a topper in the Summer Institute of Biology in 1968, he was awarded Full bright Scholarship (USA) and was associated with Texas University (Houston) and De Paul University (Chicago). Moreover he was selected for the Summer Science Research Project at Oklahoma University (Oklahoma). He attended many summer institutes in India as a resource person. In addition, he was associated with SCERT and NCERT as subject expert in Biology. He was a textbook reviewer, too. His other achievements:-

- 1. Commissioned as an NCC Officer at INS Venduruthy (Cochin) in 1962 and served as an officer of Naval Wing for 19 long years at Netarhat Residential School and retired as Chief Officer.
- 2. Received "President Award" for the best teacher in 1993.
- 3. Honoured by Bihar Pradesh Congress as the best teacher in 1996.
- 4. Honoured by Nehru Yuva Kendra, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Govt. Of India as Public Recognition of valuable services to the community as a teacher of outstanding merit on the eve of Teacher's day. 2005
- 5. Joined Vidya Vihar Residential School, Purnea as the founder Principal, afterwards



PRINCIPAL

Mr. D N Choudhary has obtained a postgraduate degree in Mathematics and a bachelor degree in Education. Mr. Choudhary had a bright academic record throughout his career. He joined this institute as a postgraduate teacher of Mathematics way back in June 1996. Prior to joining Vidya Vihar family, he had worked for about three years as a faculty in Mathematics in Purnea College, Purnea and thereafter as a postgraduate teacher of Mathematics in Jawahar Navoday Vidyalaya for about four years.

Mr. Choudhary is one of the founding teachers of this school and has contributed a lot in shaping the bright future of the students during his over 26 years of career in this institute.

He has a very strong command over his subject and he has always been very popular among the students. To showcase his leadership activities, he has always volunteered to take on responsibilities that lie outside his day to day work by stepping out of his comfort zone. This has helped him in acquiring a long range of administrative experiences also as his additional responsibilities. He was assigned the responsibility of Administrator from 27th March 2010 and onwards. He has throughout been the in-charge of Time Table and responsible for several games and sports activities in the school. For a brief spell between September 09, 2010 to April 30, 2011, he worked as Principal-in-charge also. From 1st May 2011, he was the Vice-Principal of the school until he took the charge of Principal from September 1, 2022.

PROLOGUE

In 1954, the Government of Bihar set up Netarhat Vidyalaya, with the objective of promoting excellence. The experiment proved to be a success. It provided an opportunity to a number of young and intelligent students of Bihar to become ideal and successful citizens by fusing the traditional Indian values with the modern scientific attitude.

The alumni of Netarhat Vidyalaya felt the need not only to keep the Netarhat spirit alive, but also to contribute effectively to the educational excellence of Bihar. TOWARDS ACHIEVING AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF EDUCATION

Vidya Vihar Residential School invites both male and female students from all parts of India and abroad with an objective to develop their potentialities in every walk of life. Promotion of excellence is the basic objective of this institution. Besides, achieving high academic standard, the school would like the students to develop an integrated personality. The school seeks to create conditions for an all-round development of character in which fraternity, equality and justice for all shall be the quiding principles.

The main thrust is to provide the students an opportunity to imbibe scientific knowledge at an early stage through a rich and well-stocked library and computer education, and help them evolve scientific temper. Instead of limiting education as a method of instruction, various modalities and instruments are pressed into service to enable students to undertake free inquiry with confidence.

Curricular and Co-curricular activities have been designed by experts to help students to imbibe sound moral values, a high degree of social responsibility, physical fitness and creativity.

It is Important to mention here that it was a boys school for long years. To see no boarding school for female Children around and continuous demand for such from large number of parents and guardians, the Management decided to impart value based education to girls admitting them in classes 6th, 7th, 8th and 11th.





SCHOOL AND MANAGEMENT

Vidya Vihar Residential School is a fully residential school for boys & girls from standard IV to XII and for girls six & onwards. It was the first ISO 9001 certified school of Bihar. The school campus is spread over an estate of 34 Acres in a pollution free, calm and lush green atmosphere conducive to learning and free-thinking. The school building and various other facilities have been developed well beyond the guidelines of CBSE, New Delhi. These consist of School Building, Hostels, Mess, Administrative Block, Guest House, Health Care Centre, Staff Quarters & Auditorium. Sufficient facilities have been created for a rich Library, state of the art Laboratories, ATL, Outdoor and Indoor Games, Open Air Theatre, Art & Music, Water Supply and Electricity. The school is absolutely cosmopolitan in its outlook and extends the services on the line of a public school and provides a comprehensive and liberal education for children of all communities and states.

MOTTO

Mahatma Buddha's doctrine of 'Aatmadeepo Bhav' is the motto of the school, which forms a part of the emblem.

LOCATION

The School is situated at Parora on Purnea-Dhamdaha main road at a distance of 10 Kms. from Purnea bus stand and 15 Kms from Purnea railway station. Purnea is also linked with Katihar (a major rail head on Barauni-Guwahati section) by broad-gauge. Regular bus service is available between Purnea and Parora. Tourist resort of Kajha Kothi is 4 Kms. from the location of the school.

ACADEMIC SESSION

The School session commences in April and ends in March next.









SYSTEM OF EDUCATION, CURRICULUM, MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

The school is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The school Code is 65060 and the affiliation no. is 330061. The Medium of instruction and that of communication on the campus is English. Special care is taken in the teaching of English at different levels, emphasizing the interactive skills of the students in the language. However, there is emphasis on achieving a high standard in Hindi and Sanskrit as well.







FACULTY

An excellent team of dedicated and qualified teachers drawn from all over India form the core of our faculty. Besides, Ex-teachers and old alumni of Netarhat School excelling in educational field have given consent to come to the School to guide and teach students as 'Visiting Teachers'.

COMPUTER EDUCATION

Keeping in view the strides made in Information Technology, every effort is made to impart Information Technology training to the students from class IV onwards. The computer network of the school helps the children gain latest knowledge in computers. The centre serves as an Online encyclopedia, serving the inquisitive needs of both the students and teachers.

FINE ARTS AND MUSIC

Music and Art Education is compulsory for the students from class IV to X. Besides, drawing, they are taught water- colour and oil painting etc. Depending upon their interest and talent. Classes in vocal music, instrumental music and classical dance are arranged for artistically interested students.

YOGA

Yoga is compulsory for all students. Mass yoga is practised during games period once in a week.



GAMES AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The school offers manifold training in the physical activities to the realization of the amateur's dreams and for the enrichment of their hidden talents. Physical Education is on the curriculum and special coaching after school hours is held during the games for Football, Cricket, Volleyball, Handball, Basketball, Badminton, Chess, Table Tennis, Kho Kho, Kabaddi & Athletics. Games and PT are compulsory for all students

LIBRARY

The school has two well-stocked libraries. Sufficient number of books, periodicals, newspapers and magazines are provided to help students cultivate reading habit and to become updated in respect of information and knowledge. Students are encouraged to borrow books to read in their spare time besides allotted library period in the school routine. Carefully chosen books on all subjects and for all levels charismatically silence the students and teachers and slide them into deep thought.

SECURITY

To ensure the security of pupil, identity cards are issued to Parents/Guardians. The security guards permit only the card-holders to enter the campus and meet their wards. Visitors may go around the campus with the permission of the Principal /Director only.

TRAINING IN LEADERSHIP

Students' participation in school management is encouraged and they are expected to shoulder responsibilities by holding various assignments in Class, Mess and Houses. It helps the students to develop self-confidence and leadership qualities for their future endeavours NCC & SCOUTS drills and camps also contribute for the same.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

For all-round development of students' supplementary education in an organized manner is imparted through activities. On Saturdays various activities such as cultural programmes, literary activities, quiz, movies etc are arranged in order to develop inborn qualities, and inculcate affinity to cultural milieu of our national life.

BANKER

HOSTELS (HOUSES)

There are twenty houses namely *Ramkrishna*, *Vivekanand*, *Raman*, *Dinkar*, *Renu*, *Bose*, *Aryabhatt*, *Kautilya*, *Rajendra*, *Nalanda*, *Vikramshila*, *Takshshila*, *Shastri*, *Nehru*, *Tagore*, *Gautam*, *Mahavir*, *Guru Govind*, *Dhruv* & *Saraswati*, *Gargi*, *Maitrey and Bhartii* accommodating more than 1200 students.

Each house is under the charge of a Housemaster who is directly involved in looking after the day-to-day affairs of their houses. Houses are well designed to make the students feel comfortable. Housemaster's residence is attached to the hostel. Efforts are made by the Housemasters to make boys and girls share some responsibilities related to their House.





MORNING AND EVENING ASSEMBLY

Morning Assembly starts with prayer and students are encouraged to deliver talks on various topics. Daily news and thought are read out by students in turn. Evening Assembly also starts with a prayer, followed by meditation and Evening Self Study.

PHONE CALLS

The school provides Smart Card based Guardian call facility to every student.

Students are permitted to contact their Parents/Guardians twice in a month on a specific day as per the given time schedule.

HEALTH CARE CENTRE

Health Care Centre on the campus looks after the health of the students. A Resident Medical Officer and two qualified compounders look after the medical needs. Specialized consultation is also available. Health checkups and medical consultation are free of cost. But the specialist's fee and cost of medicine is payable by the guardian of the student.

In an emergency and on medical advice, the Director/Principal/House Master sign the form of consent for the administration of anesthesia or performance of any operation on the ailing student on behalf of the parents without accepting any liability. Inoculation and vaccination and other prophylactic measures are administered to the students as per advice of Medical Officer, on instructions received from parents. Medical leave is granted to students only on the recommendation of the School Medical Officer.

SELF-STUDY

Apart from the teaching schedule of the school, there are supervised self-study periods in the Classrooms/Hostels during afternoons and evenings. There is no self-study period on Saturday evenings.

EXAMINATION & EVALUATION

The school encourages regular study by every student and promotion to higher classes depends upon the successful performance in the examination, spread over the whole academic year as per CBSE Curriculum.

COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE

The counseling care is also available to address the emotional, social and behavioral needs of the students. And to create a seamless and friendly environment to help each one of them with different approaches.





PROGRESS REPORTS

Progress report of every student is sent to the parents/ guardians giving details of the marks obtained in each subject and maximum marks in the class (subject wise) immediately after the examinations.

AWARDS & PRIZES

To inculcate a healthy spirit of competition, individual and collective prizes are given to students for achieving distinction in academics, games, sports and other co-curricular activities – Two scholarships – one of Rs. 25,000 and 15,000 are given to top two rankers of class VIII.

PROMOTION

Promotion to the next class is given to the students as per CBSE norms and School





ATTENDANCE

A Student should have a minimum of 90% attendance along with required academic achievement for promotion to the next higher class.

REMEDIAL CLASSES

Remedial Classes/Tutorials for underachievers students in required subjects are regularly arranged during the games period.

ADMISSION TEST AND SELECTION

A Written test will be held for admission in class IV, to VIII on **Sunday, 22nd January 2023 at 11:00** am at the following centers:-

- A) PURNEA Vidya Vihar Residential School, Parora, Purnea
- B) DARBHANGA/SAHARSA
- C) PATNA

Guardians are requested to collect the admit card from the Centre Superintendent one hour before the examination. Admission test will be of two hours duration. Questions will be from CBSE syllabus of the preceding standard for which admission is sought, comprising seven subjects - English, Hindi, Maths, Science, Social Science/Environmental Science, G.K. & Mental Ability.

The question booklet of class IV to VIII will contain questions in English. The students have to answer only in English except the Hindi language questions. Answers are to be written in the booklet itself. Questions will be of short answer type, multiple choice, fill in the blanks and short essays. Syllabus of concerned class can be obtained free of cost from the sale centers. Boys selected on the basis of written exam are required to appear in the interview and medical examination for the final selection. Admission formalities will be completed immediately after the publication of the final results. Parents must deposit the entire fee and other charges for the 1st Semester at the time of admission as mentioned in the fees table for First year of admissions. Hence, they are requested to come prepared at the time of interview. Results of the written test will be declared on 29th January 2023. It can be obtained from the School Office on telephone - 8448448720/ 9204068907/ 7979062808. The selected candidates will be informed about the interview date and other related matters by SMS. The venue of the interview will be Vidya Vihar Residential School, Parora (Purnea). Final result will be announced on the following day of conclusion of interviews. Parents (Father & Mother) / Guardians are required to be present at the time of interview.

Admission will be subject to medical fitness given by the medical board set up by the school. The decision of Chairman of the Selection Committee will be final for short-listing the candidates for admission after necessary selection procedure.





DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

The following documents are to be submitted at the time of joining the school (Mandatory)-

- 1. Transfer Certificate from the previous school (In Original).
- 2. Birth certificate from proper authority (Xerox Copy).
- 3. Aadhar Card (Xerox Copy)

These certificates will be retained by the school for records The date of birth recorded in the admission Register will be final and cannot be changed later. In addition to the above certificates, the following are also to be submitted duly filled in –

- 2. Medical History.
- 3. Agreement on Rs. 100/- Non-judicial stamp paper.
- 4. Declaration.
- 5. Authorization of local guardian and escort. Two coloured Passport size photos- one of the local guardian And another of the escort for identity are to be brought.
- 6. Two recent coloured passport size photos of the students.



Vacations are subject to adjustment according to the prevailing situation. Actual Days can be communicated later. Apart from the declared vacations, a student may be allowed a leave of maximum 6 days in a year for personal unavoidable genuine circumstances, festivals and similar reasons subject to the satisfaction of the Director/Principal. Guardians are therefore advised to plan such personal leave for their wards well in advance, preferably right in the beginning of the session. Guardians/parents are required to collect their wards personally on the eve of vacations. In case they are unable to come personally, they must send their representatives with proper authority letters duly signed by them. The exact duration of vacation is intimated from time to time. During long vacations boys are required to carry all their personal belongings with them so that the bed lockers/almirahs can be properly cleaned /repaired. If a boy is detained for remedial classes or for preparation of CBSE Board Exam during vacation, the parents/guardians are liable to pay extra charges for the Boarding and Lodging. Boys must be present on the closing day before vacation and also on the opening day of the school after vacation. Absence on these days will be considered as a serious breach of school discipline. If a boy does not report on the first day of the new term and his term fee is not received as per fee schedule, his name may be struck off the rolls. Leave application for absence on the first day of the term may be considered only when the term fee is deposited according to the fee schedule and the reason for absence is found genuine.

MEDICAL CARE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Sick students will report about their illness to the Housemasters who in turn will refer them to the Medical Officer of the school. The school will arrange for the procurement of medicine, the cost of which will be realized from the student's pocket money deposit.
- 2. For minor ailments parents are not informed. If situation demands, parents /guardians will be informed about the ailment.
- 3. Bespectacled students are required to bring a spare set of spectacles, and the prescription.
- 4. Boarders suffering from contagious or serious diseases like measles; mumps etc. are to be taken home by the parents for proper care and
- 5. The boarders suffering from contagious/serious diseases will be permitted to rejoin the school only after ascertaining their medical fitness. The hostellers returning to the school after recovering from any contagious disease will be examined by our school doctor and they will be allowed to join the school only after being found medically fit. The parents/ guardians suffering from any contagious disease are requested not to visit the school in any case.







If a parent/guardian wishes to withdraw his/her ward, he/she must give a minimum one-month's notice to the school in writing. The parents are required to collect all the belongings of their ward at the time of leaving the school campus after receipt of the school-leaving certificate. The school will not be responsible for any leftover belongings.



HOSTEL/ HOUSE RULES AND REGULATION

- 1. hostellers (Boarders) are required to follow the daily routine of the House and the School, unless exempted on medical ground by the Medical officer / the Principal / the Director / the Joint Director.
- 2. boarders are not permitted to stay in the House during PT, games and school hours without the permission of the Principal / Director.
- 3. students are not permitted to keep any cash, electrical appliances wristwatch or electronic items with them.
- 4. they may write letters to their parents at least once in a week preferably on Sundays and hand them over to their respective Housemaster for posting.
- 5. they may contact their Parents/Guardians through their housemasters telephonically only twice a month.
- 6. facilities of Barber, Cobbler & Tailor are available through Service Request Slips

The parents/guardians must understand that only those students, who meet our academic requirements, our behavioral standards, and our payment schedule, will be permitted to continue as members of our student body.

This is only a rough guideline and the actual discretion on these guidelines rests with the school management.



REMOVAL FROM THE HOSTEL/SCHOOL

A students can be expelled from the school if he/she is found to be a bad influence on other students or not rectifying his/her conduct/behavior detrimental to the academic environment of the school. Parents/guardians will also be asked to withdraw their wards whose performance is not found up to the laid down criteria of the school. If a child fails in the Board exam, readmission will not be granted as per the existing CBSE rules. He/she may appear as a private candidate only.

In all the cases of withdrawals or removals mentioned above, the entire amount of the hostel charges (except the remaining mess charges) paid for the whole semester will be forfeited. The school fee will be refunded on pro-rata basis as per CBSE rules. No request for return of fees/charges will be entertained on any account.



LEAVE REGULATIONS

- 1. during school term students are not generally permitted to go home.
- 2. leave may be granted for the treatment of the hostellers on Medical Officer's recommendation or on Principal's /Director's / Joint Director's discretion.
- 3. leave for three days, excluding the travelling time will be granted to attend marriage of the nearest ones i.e. sister, brother or first cousin. For this purpose invitation card of marriage should be attached with application. Leave will not be granted during examination or camps.
- 4. considering the academic interest of the students, it is suggested that Upanayan (if required) may be performed during vacation only. In unavoidable circumstances, six days leave excluding travelling time may be granted for Upanayan.
- 5. in special cases, like death of the dear ones or illness of the parents etc. leave may be granted.
- 6. for all types of leave, request should be made to the Principal / Director/ Joint Director.
- 7. parents should note the date and time when the hosteller has to return after the leave. If one has to be detained due to illness, the matter should be conveyed on phone and an application for leave should be accompanied with medical fitness certificate when the boy reports back.
- 8. after vacation students should report on the day specified, failing which they will have to pay a heavy fine. All the students are required to attend the first assembly of the new session / semester without fail.



SCHOOL REGULATIONS

- 1. Parents/Guardians will be bound by the school rules in all respects. These may be modified from time to time. In all matters of dispute, the decision of the Principal/Director will be binding on the Parents/Guardians.
- 2. The Parents/Guardians will authorise the Principal/Director and through him the staff of the school, to take relevant decisions on their behalf while they are in the school or on tours, trekking, expeditions, camps etc.
- 3. In accordance with the rules of the school, the Parents/Guardians will accept and authorise participa-tion of their wards in compulsory programmes of tours, trekking, expeditions, camps etc. during their stay at the school.
- 4. The Parents/Guardians will not hold the school responsible for indemnification against any claims arising due to illness, accident or any other cause.
- 5. The Parents/Guardians will authorise the Principal/Director to take necessary action on their behalf in case of any emergency operation or any other such condition where their permission is needed but cannot be obtained in time.
- 6. Smoking, use of alcoholic drinks or drugs, leaving school or station without permission are strictly prohibited. Students involved in any such activities will be expelled from the school.
- 7. Once a TC is given, the student concerned will collect all his/her belongings before leaving the school campus. The school will not be held responsible for his/her leftover articles.
- 8. The Principal/Director is fully empowered to remove a student from school & hostel. if, in his opinion, the student has failed to abide by the discipline of the school and his continued presence is detrimental to the interest of the other students of the school or the student fails to come up to the minimum academic standard prescribed for his class.
- 9. All parents will have to sign an agreement with the school at the time when their wards join the school.
- 10. All the students should converse only in English inside the campus to enhance their skill and fluency in the language.
- 11. Wanton damage to school property, disfiguring of walls and indecent language or behaviour are punishable offence.
- 12. Any student found to have taken other students' belongings would be punished or even suspended from the school.
- 13. Students are responsible for the safety of their belongings. While every effort is made by the school authorities to reduce the loss of such articles, the ultimate responsibility rests with the students themselves.
- 14. Fighting among the students is strictly prohibited. Groupism will lead to the suspension/expulsion of the concerned students.
- 15. A student indulging in unfair means in examination will be awarded zero in that subject & will be expelled from the school.
- **16.** Generally eatables brought from outside will not be permitted to carry to the hostel, under any circumstances.only less than 1 Kg of dry fruit is allowed.
- 17. Permission to go home is granted by Director/Principal only. Students must inform the House master after taking permission and before leaving the campus. On return they must report to the House master.
- 18. Visits by unauthorised persons are not allowed. Persons authorised by the guardians are permitted to meet the boarders on second Sundays only.
- 19. Books, magazines and periodicals not approved by the Director/Principal should not be brought to the school.

- 20 The cases that justify the removal of a boarder by the school authorities are
 - a) offences involving honesty and morality
 - b) grave and habitual insubordination
 - c) non-payment of fees
 - d) very poor academic performance
 - e) beating or harassing of any student.
 - f) wilful destruction of school properties
- 21. The school being purely residential, a student dismissed from hostel stands dismissed from the school and vice versa.
- 22. Students should not keep any money, gold ornaments, electronic items etc. The School will not be responsible for the loss of such articles.
- 23. All the belongings of the boarder should be distinctly marked by his/her Roll No. The School will not be held responsible for the loss of any such belongings.
- 24. Bullying / teasing in any form is strictly prohibited and will lead to removal from the school.



PARENTS / GUARDIANS' VISITS

- 1. The Guardians of newly admitted students are permitted to visit only after 1 Month on the 2nd Sunday of May.
- 2. Parents /Guardians/ Local Guardians are permitted to visit their wards only on 2nd Sunday of a month from 9.00 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2.30 p.m. to 5 p.m. They will meet their wards in the main building only.
- 3. Parents/Guardians/Local Guardians are not permitted to visit their wards during school hours.
- 4. The Parents/Guardians are not permitted to visit the hostels except at the time of admitting their ward.
- 5. Parents/Guardians may meet the Principal/Director on the 2nd Sundays or with prior permission on any working day between 9 am and 12 pm individually to discuss any matter pertaining to their wards or in general.

RESIDUARY

The School management reserves the right to alter/amend any of the rules in the prospectus at any time at its discretion which will be binding on parents/guardians. In addition, parents/guardians and students are expected to abide by the rules of the school enforced from time to time. Examination/Vacation dates are subject to change as per school's convenience considering the interest of students and school.







OFFICE HOURS

The following are the office hours on the working days/second Sundays for depositing fees other official assignments- 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

MEETING WITH THE HOUSE MASTERS / TEACHERS

The parents/Guardians who wish to meet the House Masters /Teachers may contact the office. The office will arrange the meeting with the teachers and House Masters on holidays. On working days, this can only be done if a teacher is free.

CAR PARKING

On entering the School campus, the parents/guard-ians/visitors must enter their particulars in the Gate Register and then park their vehicles in the Car Park areas.

DINING

Meals can be arranged for the parents and guardians at the school mess, provided a request is made to the Principal/Director well in advance or latest by 11:30 am. For this purpose coupons are available with the office. The cost of the meals will be realized from the pocket money deposit of the student concerned.

- 1. Coaching and +2 level schools are rarely integrated. The distance between school/college and coaching institute greatly affects the quality of preparation. For Instance, in Patna, schools/colleges are in Mahendru area coaching institutes are in Kankarbagh, Boring road area. In Delhi, schools/colleges may be in R K Puram/Uttam Nagar while coaching institutes are in Hauz Khas. Same phenomenon is observed at Ranchi, Bokaro, Kota, Varanasi and many such others places.
- 2. Distance between school/college and coaching institute takes away valuable time of aspirants. Commuting between school/college and coaching institute is very hectic for students. In other words, it lays extra burden on aspirants.
- 3. In above situation, aspirants feel very exhausted throughout the day. So they cannot give 100% efforts on self study which is very important to assimilate and absorb the concepts taught in the coaching sessions.
- 4. The curriculum of schools and coaching are not coordinated (both in content and pace). For example, while at a certain time if thermodynamics is being handled at School, the coaching is handling optics. In this scenario, aspirants will not be able to concentrate on either of the topics. At the end of the day, aspirants manage to gain only half-baked knowledge on both the topics
- 5. During survey, students lamented the low emphasis given to basics. Tutors tend to jump directly to advanced problems after dealing with only a couple of basic ones. This adversely affects the concept building process of aspirants. Schools think that detailed study is to be done only in coaching institutes. Ultimately students suffer from both sides.
- 6. In coaching there are number of batches formed and aspirant teacher ratio is very high (about 200:1) So these institutes lack in personal attention to aspirants. Thus, individual doubts are rarely handled or eliminated.
- 7. Initially, when an aspirant joins any coaching, his expectations are pretty high in terms of study, attention etc. After a span of time when he faces this grim reality, he/she gets disappointed. But alas precious time has already been lost. His Career Goals remain unattained.
- 8. Parents are not made aware of the regular progress of aspirant because there is no open feed back system in present school/-coaching education system.
- 9. It is practically not possible for an aspirant to buy all foreign publications books for preparation. Hence, one has to remain contented with local publications
- 10. Inaccessibility to a laboratory during preparation is another important issue. We know that laboratory plays an important role in understanding concepts. If an aspirant goes through practical learning process, his efficiency improves. In absence of lab work, rote learning (remembering and mugging of subject) doesn't help much.
- 11. Environment plays an important role in making valued aspirants.
- (A) When an aspirant goes to any metro/mega city for preparation, there are chances to fall for many bad habits like smoking, chewing tobacco, drinking, pornography, movie mania etc. in absence of proper guidance.
- (B) Non-availablity of hygienic & nutritious diet leads to many health problems, normally jaundice, typhoid.
- (C) Unlike minded people in the vicinity creates disturbance for aspirants.

After much analysis of problems with existing set-up of advanced classes system, we have PUT IN PLACE a system in Vidya Vihar which will help student in :- cracking JEE (Main/Advanced)/NEET etc.

- 10. Open feedback system in which appraisal of aspirant, faculty, management and various processes would be done regularly.

- 12. Prepare students extremely well for not only JEE/NEET/CA and board exams but for all entrance exams.
- 13. Rich library facility in school as well as in hostel.
- 14. Teaching through model and multimedia to clarify the concepts of 3D-view.
- 15. Sophisticated laboratory facilities for practical learning process.
- 16. Healthy environment to avoid any kind of deviation.
- 17. Extensive facilities of indoor and outdoor games for aspirants for quality recreation.



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






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
